Pre-Operative Instructions for IV Anesthesia

- ***Nothing to eat or drink*** (water, coffee, juice, etc.) 6-8 hours prior to your surgery appointment. However, if you must take medication prior to surgery, you may do so with only a **small sip of water**.
 - Take preoperative medications as prescribed by Dr. Lambert with a small sip of water.
- A responsible adult needs to come with you and they ***MUST STAY*** for the duration of your surgery (approx. 30- 45 minutes). * Your surgery may be cancelled if you present without an escort.
- Minors **must** be accompanied by their legal guardian.
- Wear comfortable, loose- fitting clothing.
- Remove contact lenses and jewelry prior to your procedure.
- Remove any body piercing in the facial area (tongue, lip, etc.).
- We respectfully request that relatives do not stay in treatment areas while patients are having their procedures.
